

Ceres Global Ag Corp. Announces Addition to Senior Management

Toronto, ON, January 16, 2015 – Ceres Global Ag Corp. ("Ceres" or the "Company") (TSX: CRP) announced today that it has further strengthened its commercial team with the addition of Mr. Robert Day, who will assume the role of Vice President, Trading and Risk Management for Ceres' grain division as of March 1st 2015.
