Ceres Northgate Terminal is located in southeast Saskatchewan servicing energy, industrial and agriculture sectors in Canada and the U.S.

- Links to all Class 1 railroads in North America via interchange with BNSF Railway
- Direct heavy-haul access to Western Canada, up to 62,500kg (137,788lbs)

FACILITIES

Ceres Northgate Terminal is a 1,200 acre multi-modal, multi-commodity facility designed to handle crude oil, liquefied petroleum gas, frac sand, pipe, HD equipment, other dry and liquid commodities, and agricultural products.

Ceres Northgate Terminal provides in one location:

- Liquefied Petroleum Gas transloading
- Two high efficiency 120 car unit train capable loop tracks
- Single carload and unit train shipments
- Industrial products transloading and laydown capabilities
- High throughput 26,000 ton fertilizer warehouse (completion Q1 2017)
- Tender truck scaling services
- Truck-to-rail/rail-to-truck transloading
- Long-term warehousing and storage space available
